

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

Sankhyā, the Indian Journal of Statistics and an official publication of the Indian Statistical Institute, aims to publish original, high quality research articles in all areas of Statistics. Authoritative reviews and comprehensive discussion articles in areas of important and significant current research are also welcome. Sankhyā is published in two series. Series A covers Mathematical Statistics and Probability, while Series B caters to Applied and Interdisciplinary Statistics. Series A issues are published in February and August, while Series B issues are published in May and November.

Each submission to Sankhyā undergoes an independent peer review process. Each is initially reviewed by the handling editor/co-editor and, if found suitable at this stage, it is then sent to external experts for review. It is understood that submissions made to Sankhyā are not being considered or are accepted for publication elsewhere. Sankhyā articles are abstracted/reviewed in *Mathematical Reviews* and *Zentralblatt für Mathematik*. We do not supply reprints. Authors of a published article receive one copy of the *particular* issue.

Both series of Sankhyā now have fully web-based online manuscript submission and tracking systems. For submissions to the journal, the authors should go to the respective websites for the two series. The websites for making online submissions to the two series are:

The acceptable formats for submission of articles are listed in the websites. After submission, the authors can also track the status of their submissions by logging in to the respective website using their assigned password.

Manuscripts to be submitted should be prepared, as far as possible, according to the general style followed in Sankhyā. Authors are advised to consult the latest issue for the Sankhyā style. Primary and secondary AMS subject classification numbers and some keywords and phrases should be mentioned at the bottom of the first page. A manuscript should mention institutional affiliation for each author after each author's name. A short running title should be given. A self-contained summary not exceeding 120 words is also required. Formulae should be numbered consecutively with numbers in brackets ( ) appearing in the right margin. Tables should have short explanatory headings and be numbered as Table 1, Table 8, etc. References appearing in the text should be as Roy (1956), Morgan *et al.* (1972) etc. References at the end should be listed alphabetically. Institutional address of each author with e-mail should be given at the end.
